



Solar Village Project

A timeline showing our growth over the past 6 years. To date we have completed over 20 projects and distributed thousands of solar lights to thousands of families living without access to electricity.

May 2013

The idea for Solar Village Project is born with the electrification of an off grid school in an untouchable caste village in Bihar India.



501(c)(3) Non Profit Status

Upon completion of our first full scale village electrification project we apply for and are approved as a tax exempt charitable organization.



2017 New Opportunities

We partner with the Johns Hopkins Initiative For Sustainable Energy Policy (ISEP) to do impact evaluation studies in India to determine the effectiveness of our projects. We also receive a grant from The Grand Circle Foundation to build a solar powered water filtration plant.



2018 Education Impact

We successfully fundraise for our Education Impact Project giving 300 children solar lights so ISEP can evaluate the impact it has their education.



2019 Puerto Rico Project

In collaboration with the Rock Spring Congregation of Arlington, Mutual Aid Disaster Relief and Foot Print Project in October of 2019 we installed a solar array for an off grid community center in Bucarbones Puerto Rico.



What Your Donation Will Do

- \$20 pays for 1 solar light for 1 child to use at night.
- \$200 pays for 1 200 watt solar panel for a school.
- \$500 pays for the solar power distribution system for 1 school.
- \$1,000 pays for 5 solar panels needed to power 1 school.
- \$1,500 pays for the solar racking, installation, wiring, fans, lights and outlets for the school.

Thanks to your support we begin installing solar array's on the schools and distribute the solar lights to all the kids!



June 2014

Our first full scale solar home lighting distribution takes place in Bihar India after successfully crowdfunding over \$5,000 to cover the cost of providing 100 homes with solar power.



2015-2016 Momentum Builds

We start implementing more and more projects in India and Africa, distributing thousands of solar lighting systems to thousands of homes.



2018 Solar Lighting MFI Pilot

The Rock Spring Congregation of Arlington provides us with a grant to launch our solar lighting sales pilot in India as we begin the transition to a sustainable development model.



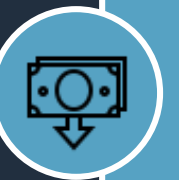
2019 Cyclone Relief Project

In May of 2019 we launch a cyclone disaster relief project in Tamil Nadu India distributing 500 solar lights to families effected by a powerful cyclone that had devastated their village.



November 2019 Fundraiser

On November 12, 2019 we launch our Sustainable Schools Initiative to bring solar power to 300 students and 3 schools in rural India. We will be fundraising for this project through late December. As always we could use your support!
